## Apply for a Deutschlandstipendium

SRH Berlin University of Applied Sciences is an official partner of the Deutschlandstipendium (Germany Scholarship).

SRH Förderstiftung is offering **8** (eight) Germany Scholarship. Further scholarships may be awarded later each year. The application deadline is **1 April 2021**. The scholarships will be paid from 1 April 2021 as well.

### Who can apply?

You are eligible to apply if you are an **enrolled student of any school of SRH Berlin University of Applied Sciences or will be enrolled by the summer semester 2021**, You should also...

- Have obtained very good grades in your studies,
- Be enrolled for at least another year,
- Not receive other scholarships.

A **written application** is required to participate in the selection process. Please fill out the application form and send your complete application in **a single e-mail (only PDF or DOC files)** to [deutschlandstipendium.hsbe@srh.de](mailto:deutschlandstipendium.hsbe@srh.de)

**Attention: handwritten documents, incomplete applications and applications submitted after the deadline will not be considered!**

### Application documents

We can **only** accept complete applications. Please fill out the application form and submit the following documents:

- Filled out and signed application form
- Letter of motivation regarding your choice of study programme (max. 2 pages DIN A4),
- Curriculum Vitae with recent photograph,
- Copy of the university entrance qualification certificate, for foreign certificates a translation transferable to the German grading system,
- If applicable: certificate of undergraduate degree (e.g. bachelor's degree) or similar, which qualifies the candidate to study at SRH Berlin University of Applied Sciences,

- Transcript of records (grades) of current studies,
- Letter of recommendation from a professor or lecturer of the respective field of studies or from a teacher of the last secondary school. **Please use the provided form,**
- Further proof that may be relevant for the scholarship (e.g. proof of volunteer work, letters of recommendation). **You must provide proof of every work experience / volunteer activities relevant to your application,**
- Current certificate of enrolment or proof of application for the upcoming semester.

## Selection criteria

SRH Berlin University of Applied Sciences awards scholarships according to the scholarship law and the selection criteria defined in the Deutschlandstipendium university guidelines:

- For first semester students: the average grade of their university entrance qualification (e.g. Abitur),
- For students who have been enrolled for at least one semester: their academic performance (grades), for students in a master's degree programme also the final grade of their undergraduate degree.

The Deutschlandstipendium is a **merit-based scholarship programme**. Former scholarship holders had average grades of 1.3 or higher.

In order to consider the applicants full potential, further criteria such as personal background, awards, work and international experience, extracurricular activities (volunteer work, social or political commitment, etc.), collaboration with clubs or organizations, the letter of motivation and other personal and family circumstances will be taken into consideration.

## **General conditions**

The sponsorship of the selected students starts on 1 April 2021. Scholarship holders receive 300 Euros/month for the period of one year (allowance period), on the condition that they remain enrolled at SRH Berlin University of Applied Sciences for the entire period.

The scholarship is independent of income and therefore can be combined with BAföG. Double funding through other performance-based scholarship programmes is not permitted. This does not apply if the funding received by the student falls under 30 Euros/month.

There is no legal claim to the scholarship.
